Contribute to routine building maintenance including cleaning, light painting, and repair projects Help with the yearly set-up, clean-up, and summer maintenance of the beach and kayak area Assist with all trail and grounds work including the maintenance of trail systems (e.g. trimming, pruning, and repair of boardwalks and bridges) and lawn mowing Participate in the set-up and clean-up of Preserve events and programs as needed Contribute to team effort by performing other related duties as required

Requirements:

Must be 18 years old

Use of a personal vehicle will be required.

May be required to drive Huyck Preserve pickup truck

Ability to work independently and as part of a team

Ability to work outdoors in all weather conditions, to navigate rugged terrain, and to carry and operate equipment needed to carry out land management operations

Willingness to be trained in operating weed and hedge trimmers

Interest in outdoor, physical labor

All staff must adhere to the Huyck Preserve's Covid--19 protocols and be fully vaccinated against Covid-19 (accommodations may be made for medical or religious needs).

Must successfully complete a criminal background check and a DOT driving record check before an offer of employment is made
