The Huyck Preserve and Biological Research Station is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization located on 2,000+ acres in Rensselaerville, New York. ## **Myosotis Lake Lifeguard**

The Huyck Preserve and Biological Research Station is now accepting applications for summer 2024 lifeguards at Lake Myosotis Beach in Rensselaerville, NY. Multiple part-time, approximately ten-week positions are available. Applicants must be at least 16 years of age and have current American Red Cross Lifeguard Certification <u>with Waterfront</u> and current American Red Cross certification in CPR/AED by the time the position begins. The costs of acquiring certification will be covered by the Huyck Preserve.

#### **Responsibilities Include:**

Ensuring the safety of lake patrons including preventing and responding to accidents and injuries Enforcing beach rules including administering swim tests and ensuring proper behavior of patrons

Surveying the beach area for hazards

Completing daily beach logs and incident reports in case of emergency or accident

Signing in pass holders at the gate

Maintaining a clean beach and facility

Training every two weeks on lifesaving skills and physical fitness

#### **Duration:**

This is an approximately ten-week position running from June 22 to September 2, 2024. Orientation for this position will be held before June 22 based on the schedule of lifeguards and the Buildings and Grounds Supervisor.

The beach is open Wednesday to Sunday from 1-8pm in June and July and from 1-7pm in August. Additional time for set-up and clean-up will be required. Inclement weather may affect hours worked.

Salary: starts at \$16/hour

#### **Required Qualifications:**

Must be at least 16 years of age

Must hold current American Red Cross Lifeguard Certification <u>with Waterfront</u> and current American Red Cross certification in CPR/AED. The Huyck Preserve will pay for the cost of certification.

Must be able to work outside and fulfill all of the physical duties of the job

Finalists over 18 years of age must successfully complete a criminal background check and DOT driving record check before an offer of employment is made.

Must have experience with or interest in working with the public
