

## Paper Bag Frog

Recommended ages - all ages! Parent supervision is encouraged.

Create an adorable frog with a paper bag and some paint.

## Materials:

- paper lunch bag
- green paint
- pink paint
- paintbrush
- cardstock or construction paper (green, white, red)
- scissors
- glue stick
- black marker

## Instructions:

- 1. Paint the bag green, and, after it has dried, paint the section underneath the flap pink for the frog's mouth.
- 2. On the green cardstock paper, draw and cut out legs.
- 3. On the white cardstock paper, draw and cut out eyes.
- 4. On the red cardstock paper, cut out a long tongue. Curl your red strip of paper tightly around a pencil or your finger to curl it. Then, glue the paper under the front flap of the bag inside the frog mouth.
- 5. Glue the eyes and legs to the paper bag, with the eyes at the bottom of the bag on top of the flap.
- 6. Using the marker, color in the pupils of the eyes. Paint or marker the lids green.
- 7. Get creative! Use the marker or other paints to decorate your frog to make your individualized amphibian!
