

Paper Bag Frog

Recommended ages - all ages! Parent supervision is encouraged.

Create an adorable frog with a paper bag and some paint.

Materials:

- paper lunch bag
- green paint
- pink paint
- paintbrush
- cardstock or construction paper (green, white, red)
- scissors
- glue stick
- black marker



Instructions:

1. Paint the bag green, and, after it has dried, paint the section underneath the flap pink for the frog's mouth.
2. On the green cardstock paper, draw and cut out legs.
3. On the white cardstock paper, draw and cut out eyes.
4. On the red cardstock paper, cut out a long tongue. Curl your red strip of paper tightly around a pencil or your finger to curl it. Then, glue the paper under the front flap of the bag inside the frog mouth.
5. Glue the eyes and legs to the paper bag, with the eyes at the bottom of the bag on top of the flap.
6. Using the marker, color in the pupils of the eyes. Paint or marker the lids green.
7. Get creative! Use the marker or other paints to decorate your frog to make your individualized amphibian!
